Part-time experienced position

Snohomish County Fire District 5 is offering part-time positions for qualified individuals.

To qualify you will need to have:

- IFSAC firefighter 1 or equivalent
- Washington State certified EMT or active NREMT
- Valid Washington State driver license and obtain EVIP certification within 6 months of hire.
- Pass a background check

What you are required to do:

- Have a current passing CPAT test less than one year old or pass Fire District 5 physical agility test.

To become “shift qualified” you must complete our lateral transfer form that includes:

Aid rig check off, mapping, report writing, radio communication, NIMS 100,200, 700, 800 we will also observe your patient contacts and proficiency.

Show your proficiency as a Firefighter and learn the nuances of how our Engines are loaded and hose evolutions.

You will be required to work a minimum of four, twelve hour shifts per month and attend at least two, two hour drills per month.

What we will do for you:

- Provide the necessary training for you to enhance your current skills and maintain existing ones.

Work as a team member in a dynamic structure to achieve goals. Obtain exposure to many different types of calls: EMS, Fire, motor vehicle collisions, and rescue.

We have a very flexible shift schedule, 12 hour night and day shifts plus opportunities to assist with special events.

Assist in developing your engineer skill, Instructor 1, Hazmat Operations, Firefighter 2, AEMT, Wildland and State Mobilizations.

We have a good workout facility and personnel that will help push you to keep progressing in your fitness.

Shift qualified personnel earn \$9.04 per hour while working shifts.
